## Music curriculum overview



At Fordley, KS1 are taught unit each half term and KS2 are taught music on alternating half terns. In these units of learning, children study musical pieces across a variety of genres whilst being taught how to sing, play an instrument, how to improvise and how to compose. Charanga is used as a resource to support children and staff in playing instruments, composing and improvising. Musical notation is taught from supplementary resources created by the music lead in alignment with the units selected from Charanga to ensure progressive learning in small steps.



Pupils sing regularly and frequently across the school year in assemblies and in preparation for musical enrichment. Assembly leads model good singing practice including posture and breathing to reinforce learning from taught units of learning.
