Have a lovely weekend and thank you for your ongoing support of our happy, nurturing and successful school.

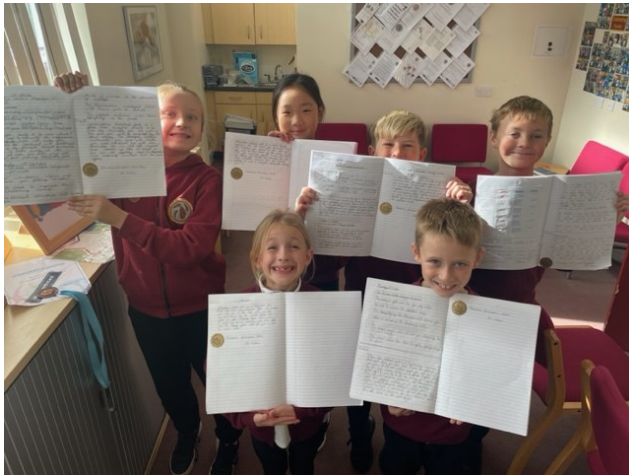

Amazing Successes from Home and in School

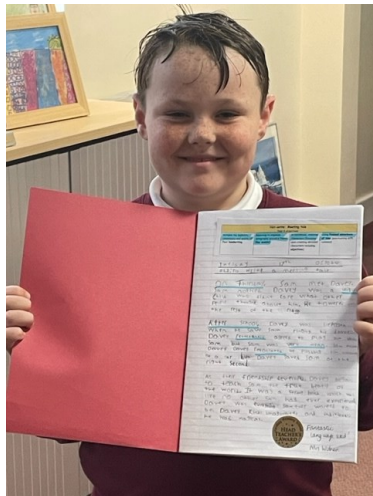
So many successes from school and home this week that I have struggled to fit them all in!
