Dear Fordley Family,

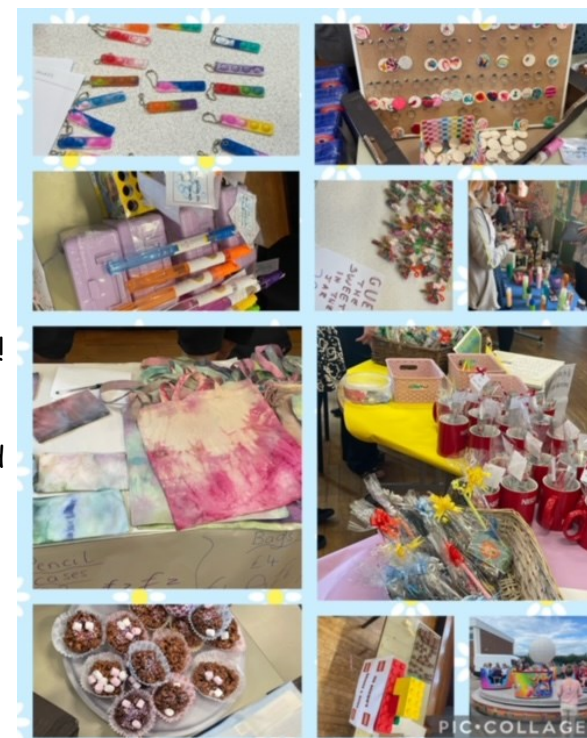

Thank you for your ongoing support of our happy, nurturing, hard-working and successful school. I hope you all have a fantastic weekend.

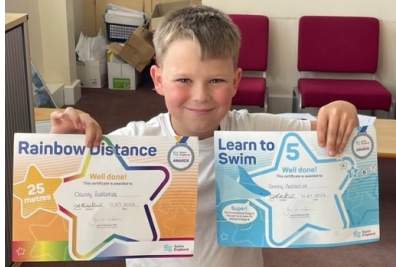
